## AMBASSADOR ACHIEVEMENT BADGES

The Y on Earth Community's Ambassador Achievement Badges (AAB's) represent the work, leadership, and commitment of our community, and are a way to document and celebrate each other's accomplishments.



Community Impact Ambassador – represents full activation of Ambassador status, excellence in community leadership, demonstration of healthy lifestyle and responsible consumer choices, and embodiment of our regeneration, stewardship, sustainability, and kindness ethics.



Global Advisory Board – indicates membership in our advisory body, which works closely with the Executive Management team and Board of Directors in order to develop and deploy strategy, build strategic partnerships, and support the organization's fund-raising efforts.



**Stewardship Circle** – this achievement is attained by individuals and organizations whose generous support helps to underwrite our podcast series, community mobilization resources, specially curated workshops and events, and the growth and activation of our ambassador network.



Youth Advisory Council – comprised of extraordinary youth leaders, this special council keeps us engaged with younger ambassadors and activists, and enhances the inter-generational connectivity, sharing, and learning among our network of friends, allies, ambassadors, and our Global Advisory Board.



Indigenous Wisdom & Folk Ways Council – re-weaving indigenous and folk-ways wisdom into our culture in these momentous times is of paramount importance. The Original Instructions have guided the ecological stewardship and community-based cultural mores of native peoples world-wide since time immemorial, a living wisdom that is essential to the restoration of Earth and the healing of our societies.



**Sophia Wisdom & Grandmother Council** – this special body, inspired by the traditional cultural structure of the Haudenosaunee (the "People of the Longhouse" a.k.a. the Iroquois Confederation), honors the special wisdom of the grandmothers and wise women in our community, who embody the grace of the divine feminine, and provide supportive guidance, wisdom, and prayers to our ongoing work.



Viriditas Society – named for the term coined by mystic Hildegard von Bingen, which denotes "the Divine healing energy of plants," this special by-invitation body is fashioned after the initiatic societies of indigenous cultures and the esoteric mystery schools of the ancients, and is established for the practice and dissemination of ceremonial arts based on ancient, indigenous, and esoteric land-alchemy, healing, biophilia, and vitalizing traditions.



**Podcast Guest** – based on their demonstrated leadership, unique accomplishments, and ability to articulate important information, some of our Ambassadors are invited to be a guest on our Y on Earth Community Podcast & Videocast series.







Generator Circle – acknowledges the video content generation and sharing via our web platform and social media channels. Bronze, Silver, and Gold levels reflect quality and quantity of publications (details forthcoming).







**Event Host** – organizers and curators of Y on Earth Community events help inform and inspire in their communities, workplaces, houses of worship, and neighborhoods, sharing soil-regeneration, health, wellness, stewardship and sustainability education.







Leadership Credentials – there are three tiers of leadership training achievements. The first step is attending a Leadership Summit, followed by Advanced Leadership Training, and culminating in certification to earn revenue by speaking and teaching on behalf of the Y on Earth Community.







**Monthly Supporter** – the community mobilization, ambassador platform, podcast series, and other stewardship and resilience resources are made possible in part by the generous monthly support of our Ambassadors.



Y on Earth Product & Resource Affiliate – earn revenue by offering the books, videos, soil-building and wellness resources made available through the Y on Earth Community. This is a win/win/win example of regenerative economics and social enterprising for multiple benefits.







Wele Waters Affiliate – a social enterprise whose profits are contributed to the Y on Earth Community, Wele Waters provides hand-crafted, hemp and aromatherapy infused soaking salts, therapeutic salves, and massage and body oils produced with the finest organic, biodynamic, and sustainably grown ingredients.



1% for the Planet – participation in the growing global network of individuals and corporations donating 1% of earnings to environmental non-profits. Ambassadors earning this badge can make their donation to the Y on Earth Community, or to 1000s of other great organizations.







**Book Report** – reading and sharing a written or video summary of one or more of the Y on Earth Community collection of books and/or books on our recommended reading list provides others a cogent synopsis of why the books are important, how they affected us personally, and how they're enhancing our mobilization work.



**Book Club** – organizing and hosting weekly or monthly book club discussions is a great way to engage community, whether gathering in person or via a video conference. The Y on Earth Community provides special bulk discounts on printed, e-book and audiobook resources to support book clubs.







Biodynamic Stewardship – reflects soil, land, water, plant, and community stewardship using biodynamic preparations in the tradition articulated by Rudolf Steiner. Three tiers signify soil activation, preparation making, and biodynamic farming.








**Ecosystem Restoration Camps** – collaborating in a world-wide movement for land restoration, regeneration, and stewardship, these community-based projects are a tremendous vehicle for layered agricultural, environmental, cultural, and economic benefits.















**Permaculture Installation** – designing and establishing Permaculture projects: earth sculpting, companion and polyculture forest-garden plantings, soil building, and edible landscapes are created at home, multiple locations, and for others' sites.







**Tree Planting** – recognizing and celebrating the planting of trees as an essential ecosystem restoration and climate stabilization activity. This badge sequence starts at planting one tree (Bronze), passes to 100 tress (Silver), and culminates with 1,000 tress (Gold).



Gardening – celebrating our connection with living soil, flowers, herbs, vegetables and other garden dwellers, this badge represents garden cultivation, a core activity that is foundational to our regeneration, healing, stewardship, and thriving practices.
